APPLICABILITY/ACCOUNTABILITY

This policy applies to all university departments, units, and direct support organizations providing financial resources for students.

POLICY STATEMENT

The Office of Student Financial Assistance is responsible for the coordination of all federal, state, private, and institutional financial resources for students.

DEFINITIONS

Coordination. Federal guidelines require that student financial resources are routed through a central location to properly apply awarding criteria. In addition, the university must comply with Board of Governors' reporting requirements.

Financial resources. Funds, financial considerations, or non-compensation resources provided to students while in attendance at the university. Financial resources may include, but are not limited to, tuition or other financial waivers, scholarships, reduction in housing fees for resident assistants, work-study, departmental payments on behalf of students, or other departmental payments to students which could be used for educational expenses.

PROCEDURES:

There are several types of financial assistance that students can obtain. The procedures for obtaining financial assistance can be found on the Office of Student Financial Assistance website, <u>finaid.ucf.edu</u>.

FINANCIAL AID REPORTING

In compliance with federal regulations, the university requires students receiving any form of financial aid to report awards from foundations or other sources and have their financial aid packages adjusted appropriately. Adjustment may be one of the following:

- A financial aid award that the student has already received in the current semester or may receive in a subsequent semester, and /or
- A student's overall cost of attendance budget.

The Office of Student Financial Assistance (SFA) has the responsibility to determine whether adjustments are necessary.

Colleges/departments have the responsibility to inform SFA about student's financial assistance and to inform SFA of the term for which the payment is effective.
